- The Management should follow the provisions of the Telangana Education Act I of 1982/G.O.Ms.No.1, Edn., Dated 01.01.1994 as amended from time to time and Telugu Language must be imparted as 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Language compulsorily.
